GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS COSMETICS EUROPE SCIENCE CONFERENCE

By registering for the 2017 Cosmetics Europe Science Conference (hereinafter referred to as the “Cosmetics Europe Science Conference” or the “Conference”), Participants agree to the following terms and conditions:

ORGANISER

1. The Cosmetics Europe Science Conference is organized by Cosmetics Europe on 26 and 27 October 2017.

REGISTRATION

2. Registrations to the Cosmetics Europe Science Conference are to be made on the online services provided on the registration platform. Registrations can be made until 16 October 2017 or until the maximum number of participants has been reached.

REGISTRATION FEE

3. Upon registration to the Cosmetics Europe Science Conference, Participant will be invited to pay the registration fee either by using the online services provided on the registration platform or by bank transfer as per the instructions provided on the online platform.
4. Participation will not be possible without prior payment of the registration fee.
5. The registration fees are:

(*) The Students category also includes PhD Students. Students must be able to provide evidence of their student status (student card) upon request.



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6. The registration fee includes the participation to the Conference, the Conference documents that will be provided to the Participants by Cosmetics Europe, lunches and beverages provided during the Conference and the networking cocktail.
7. The Participant must cover his/her own travel and accommodation expenses and make these arrangements on his/her own. Cosmetics Europe assumes no responsibility for the reservation of accommodation.
8. Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for health and travel insurance. The registration fee does not include insurance.

CONFIRMATION

9. A registration confirmation will be sent by email to the Participant after the online registration and related payment have been received by Cosmetics Europe. The Participant may be requested to present this registration confirmation at the registration counter as proof of his/her registration and payment.

CANCELLATION POLICY

10. Notice of cancellation must be made in writing by email to Cosmetics Europe (accounts@cosmetiscseurope.eu) and include all relevant information regarding the bank account to which a possible refund may be remitted. Provided the notice of cancellation is made according to the above requirements and before 28 September 2017, the registration fee will be refunded in full (less a 25 Euros administrative charge) to the Participant.

USE OF PERSONAL DATA

11. Upon registration to the Cosmetics Europe Science Conference, Participant's details such as name, surname, institution, country and email address, but also any other details the Participant might submit will be collected to prepare a participant list for the benefit of all Participants. These details may also be available to parties directly related to the events including the venues and accommodation providers.



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12. Cosmetics Europe may use these data to inform the Participants of updates or future conferences via email.
13. The collected data will be processed electronically and on paper as strictly necessary for the organization of Cosmetics Europe events.
14. During the Conference, Cosmetics Europe or its representatives may photograph and/or film Participants. Cosmetics Europe may use photographs and/or videos bearing Participants' image in any format type for posting on the Conference website, Cosmetics Europe's website and in Cosmetics Europe's next year's annual report and for archiving in Cosmetics Europe's IT systems.
15. By registering to Cosmetics Europe Science Conference, Participants consent to the processing of their personal data, including photographs and/or videos bearing their image, by Cosmetics Europe in accordance with applicable data protection laws strictly for the abovementioned purposes.
16. Each Participant has the right, as data subject, to access data relating to him/her, to be informed about the existence and the extent of data processing, to rectify incorrect personal data and to oppose further processing on serious and legitimate grounds. To exercise these rights, Participants are requested to contact Cosmetics Europe at the following email address: scienceconference@cosmeticseurope.eu. This consent shall apply worldwide and for as long as the Participant's personal data is subject to legal protection. It can be withdrawn partly or in whole by informing Cosmetics Europe at the address mentioned above.

PROPRIETARY RIGHTS

17. All content and material made available during or related to the Cosmetics Europe Sciences Conference are protected by property rights. Except as expressly authorized by Cosmetics Europe, Participants may not sell, license, rent, modify, distribute, copy, reproduce, transmit, publicly display, publicly perform, publish, adapt, edit, or create derivative works from such materials or content.

LIABILITY

Cancellation of the Conference



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18. In the event that the Conference cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of Cosmetics Europe (*force majeure*) or due to events which are not attributable to gross negligence ("*faute lourde*") or willful misconduct ("*dol*"), Cosmetics Europe cannot be held liable. Under these circumstances, Cosmetics Europe will reimburse the Participants the registration fee after deducting costs already incurred for the organization of the Conference and which could not be recovered from third parties.

Modification of the Conference programme

19. Cosmetics Europe reserves the right to modify the Conference programme.

Disclaimer

20. As regards the Conference, the liability of Cosmetics Europe shall be limited to its gross negligence ("*faute lourde*") or willful misconduct ("*dol*"). In any cases, Cosmetics Europe shall not be liable for (a) any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs or financial losses, (b) any loss of business, revenue, profits, anticipated savings, opportunity, goodwill, use, data, whether arising directly or indirectly, or (c) for any indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential damages.
21. Presenters alone are responsible for the content of their respective presentations and/or handouts, which are offered for informational purposes only. The views and opinions expressed in the presentations/handouts are not necessarily those of Cosmetics Europe and are not endorsed by Cosmetics Europe. Cosmetics Europe disclaims any and all legal liability for the content expressed in the presentations or materials distributed as a part of a presentation.

Participation to the Conference

22. The hotel where the Conference is held is a non-smoking hotel. It is therefore prohibited to smoke in the hotel premises. Participants who do not observe this non-smoking rule do so under their own responsibility and expose themselves to potential fines and/or additional fees.
23. Participants are expected to behave professionally. Participants are liable for the damages they cause to other persons and/or to other persons' or the hotel's property.



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24. Participants take part in the Conference at their own risks. In particular, Cosmetics Europe cannot be responsible for healthcare and/or ambulance services during the Conference.

Therefore, Cosmetics Europe strongly recommends Participants to take out comprehensive medical and travel insurance, which should cover the possibility of flight cancellation due to strikes and other causes.

OTHER LEGAL PROVISIONS

25. Should individual provisions of these general terms and conditions be invalid, this shall have no effect on the validity of the remaining provisions.
26. These general terms and conditions shall be governed in all respects by the laws of Belgium, excluding its conflicts of laws provisions. In case of a dispute arising out of or in connection with these general terms and conditions, the courts of Brussels shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute which may arise under or in connection with these general terms and conditions.
